TERMS & CONDITIONS

Name of Work : Interior & Exterior Decoration of Stall during Island Tourism Festival 2008-09.

Situation of Work : ITF Ground, Port Blair.

1. The work, in general, shall be executed as per the description of item.
2. The time limit for the completion of work is **07 days**, which shall be reckoned from 2nd day of date of issue of work order to commence the work. If the work is not completed within the stipulated period the work order will be cancelled and the work will be undertaken by other means and compensation @1% per day for delay shall be recovered from the Contractor. The total amount of compensation shall not exceed 10% of the tendered Value/Work Order.
3. The rates quoted should be specified both in words and figures.
4. The contractor shall execute the work as per the direction of the Engineer-in-charge during.
5. No Tools & Plants will be issued by the Corporation to the Contractor.
6. The contractor at his own cost shall arrange the water and all the materials required for the work.
7. If the contractor is storing materials issued by the Department at the site of work in his godown, the responsibility shall be rest with the contractor to avoid pilferage and misuse of Govt. materials.
8. The contractor shall be responsible for the safe custody and damage of materials if any issued to him.
9. Marine Ply wood to be used for centering and shuttering works.
10. High standard of workmanship should be maintained and the contractor should ensure that only skilled and experienced trade men are employed.
11. The contractor shall execute the whole and every part of the work in the most substantial and workman like manner and both as regards and otherwise in every respect in strict accordance with the specifications/drawings
12. All safety precautions should be taken by the contractor and any loss or damage to men and materials during execution of work should be borne by the contractor only.
13. In case of Extension/Postponement of ITF the contractor shall execute the work as and when required by the direction of Engineer-in-charge and nothing shall be paid extra.
14. During the execution of work if the contractor or his workmen do any damages to the Govt. property, the contractor should rectify and make the same good at his own expenses.
15. Any defective work noticed during the ITF will be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.

16. The site should be cleared by the contractor immediately after completion of work.
17. Labour clearance Certificate should be produced by the contractor from the Labour Welfare Office before payment in case of complaint.
18. Income Tax shall be deducted as per rules.
19. The contractor has to submit the bill with full details of measurement for release of payment. The payment will be made in single bill on first and final bill basis and no part payment will be entertained during the execution of work.
20. After satisfactory completion of work the contractor shall submit the pre- receipted bill in duplicate for making payment by the Corporation and payment shall be released only after completion of ITF and clearance of site.
21. In case of any dispute the decision of General Manager, ANIIDCO Port Blair shall be final and binding.
